

**LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN DEARBORN BOARD

ASSOCIATION OF DEARBORN SCHOOLS ADMINISTRATORS'**


The Dearborn Board (hereinafter referred to as the Board), as the Association of Dearborn Schools Administrators' (hereinafter referred to as the ADSA), whereas the above mentioned parties agree as follows:

The parties agree that administrators who earn Relief Days (Article XI - Section K) can use those days at anytime during the 2015-16 school year. Relief Days are earned by administrators who work additional hours outside the scope of a regular school day. An administrator will need written approval for these days by their supervisor and will need to submit required paperwork. An administrator can utilize a minimum of two days unless both parties agree to additional days requested by said administrator. This agreement can be utilized by all ADSA members.

This working agreement will expire at the end of the 2017-18 school year.
